## **Cadet Corps History**

- Founded on April 5, 1911
- Brigadier General Edwin Alexander Forbes
- · Forbes is the "Father" of the Cadet Corps
  - Adjutant General of the State of California in 1911
  - Decided to start a program called the CA High School Cadets to train officers for the impending WWI. In 1935, the name was changed to the California Cadet Corps.




#### Develop SKILLS OF HEALTH, WELLNESS and FITNESS
