Cornell Note Taking System

1. Record (during lecture) write down facts and ideas in phrases use abbreviation when possible

> (after lecture) read through you notes fill in blanks and make scribbles more legible

2. Reduce or Question (after lecture) write key words, phrases or questions that serve as cue for notes taken in class cue phrases and question should be in your own words

3. Recite

with classroom notes covered, read each key word or question

recite the fact or idea brought to mind by key word or question

4. & 5 Reflect and Review

review your notes periodically by reading think about what you have learned

6. Recapitulation (after lecture) summarize each main idea use complete sentence
