First General Order

- I will guard everything within the limits of my post and quit my post only when properly relieved.

- I will do my job as assigned
- I will only quit when I have finished the job
- I will make sure that the job is done properly



Second General Order

- I will obey my special orders and perform my duties in a military manner.



- I will listen to instructions from those in positions over me
- I will obey those instructions
- I will act in a military manner in all that I do
 - Respectful
 - Representing myself and my unit well
 - Mature and serious
 - Military bearing - appearance and carriage.

Third General Order



- I will report violations of my special orders, emergencies, or anything not covered in my instructions to the commander of the relief.
 - I will let my leaders know if I have problems getting the job done
 - I will let my leaders know about any emergencies or unforeseen problems while I am doing my job
 - If a problem occurs I don't know how to solve, I will let my leaders know

Purpose of General Orders

- When you do guard duty, these guide your behaviors
 - Guarding your post and quit only when relieved
 - Obey instructions and take the job seriously
 - Tell the commander of any problems while you are on duty
- The ideas mentioned on the previous slides are applicable to all we do as cadets.
