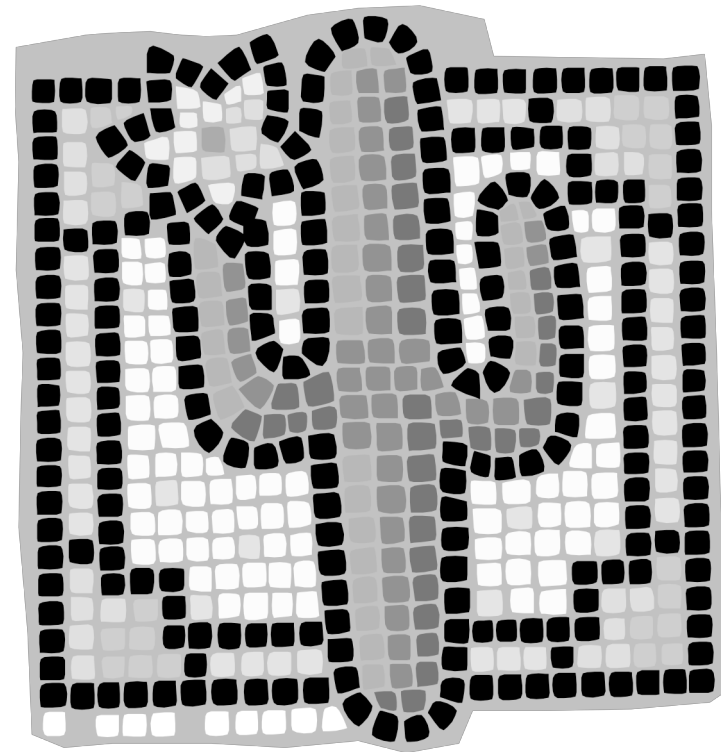

UNSELFISHNESS

- Not being most concerned with yourself and your needs

- Sharing what you have with others

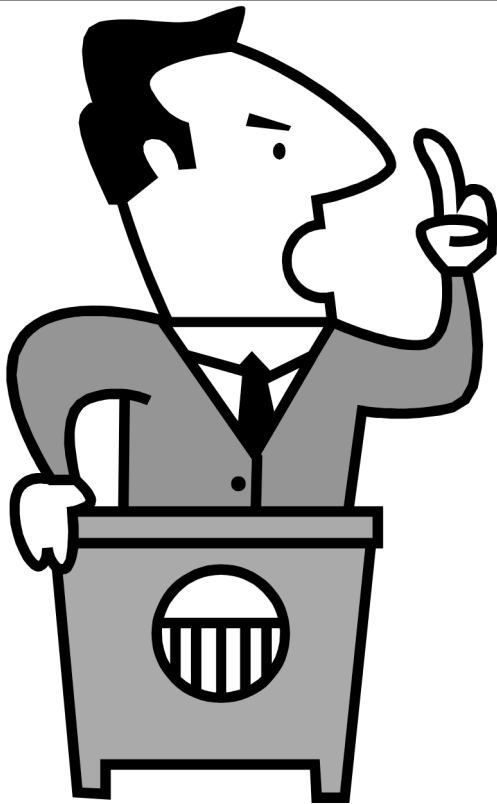


COURAGE



- Facing danger or uncomfortable situations with self-confidence; not allowing your fears to overpower you
- This does not mean you cannot be afraid; it just means you do not let your fear control you

Examples of Courage



- The obvious: saving the baby from the burning building
- The not-so-obvious:
 - saying no to someone when they ask you to do something wrong
 - Stopping someone who is breaking the law or about to break the law
 - Protecting the underdog
