- Ways that people can serve their country include running for **OFFICE**, using the free **PRESS** to speak out on important issues, joining labor **UNIONS** if you wish, and joining private **VOLUNTEER** organizations.
- It is important that citizens **VOTE** in each election, pay careful **ATTENTION** to the process of electing representatives, join political **PARTIES** and participate in **CAMPAIGNS**. It is important to remember, too, that your political party may not always be in **POWER**, but that is part of the process.
