<u>J</u> 5. Foul Ball	e. One of the early games that softball resembles (seems like)
<u>G</u> 6. Ball	f. Three of these are allowed per inning per team
<u>B</u> 7. Batter's Box	g. When a batter does not swing at a pitch that is outside the strike zone
