In the two boxes below, draw two different types of shelters you could make in a survival situation. You will be evaluated on the basis of how well your shelter drawing depicts (shows) something that reasonably could be built in a survival situation with the materials you would find in the wilderness.

Your drawing will be evaluated on the basis of the following rubric:

- 4 = Drawings show a complete shelter which could reasonably be built using materials you would find in a wilderness situation. Drawing includes labels which identify the materials being used.
- 3 = Drawings show a complete shelter which MIGHT be able to be built using materials you would find in wilderness situation. There are no labels for materials.
- 2 = Drawings show an incomplete shelter or one which would likely provide little shelter from the elements. Materials to be used are incomplete or not obvious.
- 1 = Shelter is completely unlivable and/or unnatural materials were used in its construction.
