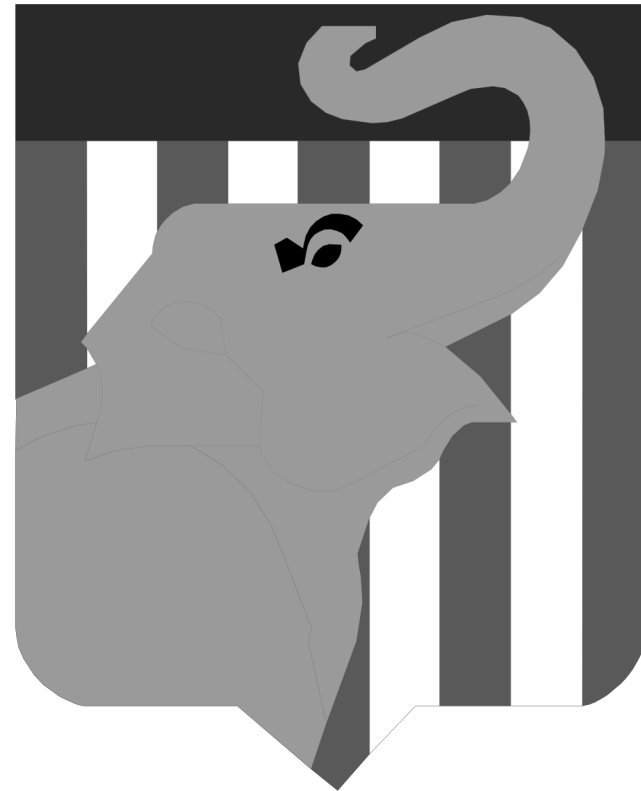

1901 to 1909

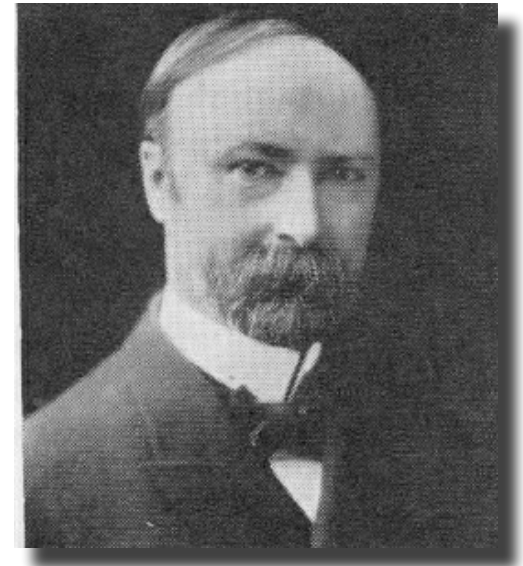
Political Party

Some major accomplishments



- Ensured the construction of the Panama Canal
- Reached a Gentlemen's Agreement on immigration with Japan
- Added Enormously to the National Forest in the West
- Reserved lands for public use
- Fostered great irrigation projects
- Crusaded endlessly on matters big and small

What were his major accomplishments while in office?

- Recognized the Republic of Panama and began construction of the Panama Canal
- Negotiated the peace treaty ending the Russian-Japanese War
- Won the Nobel peace Prize
- Planned and attended the Tennessee Coal and Iron Conference
- Pushed through and important law known as the Employer's Liability Act

What military action took place during his presidency?

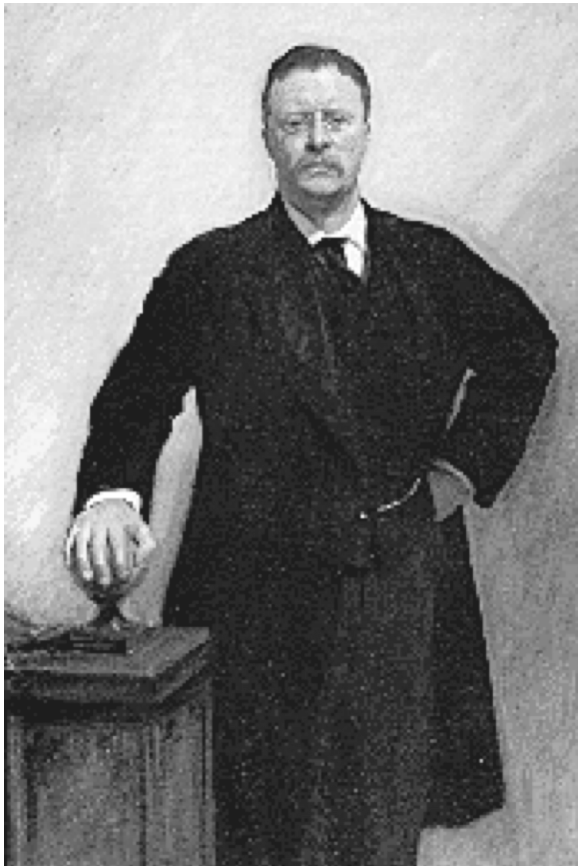
- Spanish and American War
