


Neil Armstrong

First Man on the Moon



Early Military Career

- Served as a naval aviator • from 1949-1952
- Joined the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics (NACA) which later became NASA (the National Aeronautics and Space Administration)
- · Served as a research pilot at NASA's Flight Research Center at Edwards AFB, CA



Experimental Pilot



• Was the project pilot on the X-15 aircraft, the first plane to fly 4000 mph

Has flown over 200 different models of aircraft, including jets, rockets, helicopters, and gliders

Astronaut Armstrong



Transferred to astronaut status in 1962 and commanded the Gemini 8 mission which performed the first successful docking of two vehicles in space

Lunar Mission

- Commanded Apollo 11, the first manned lunar mission
- First man to land an aircraft on the moon and first to step on the moon's surface



After NASA



- Served as a Professor of Aerospace Engineering at the University of Cincinnati
- Is currently the Chairman of the Board of AIL systems in New York, an electronic systems company.
