**Early Life**



- Born in Wapakoneta, Ohio on August 5, 1930
- Received a Bachelor of Science degree in Aeronautical Engineering from Purdue University in 1955

**Early Military Career**

- Served as a naval aviator from 1949-1952
- Joined the National Advisory Committee for Aeronautics (NACA) which later became NASA (the National Aeronautics and Space Administration)
- Served as a research pilot at NASA's Flight Research Center at Edwards AFB, CA

**Experimental Pilot**



- Was the project pilot on the X-15 aircraft, the first plane to fly 4000 mph
- Has flown over 200 different models of aircraft, including jets, rockets, helicopters, and gliders

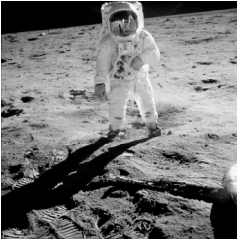

**Astronaut Armstrong**



- Transferred to astronaut status in 1962 and commanded the Gemini 8 mission which performed the first successful docking of two vehicles in space

**Lunar Mission**

- Commanded Apollo 11, the first manned lunar mission
