
The Bowling Lane

- Has dots to help you line up correctly
- Has arrows to help you line up the ball with the bowling pins
- Has a foul line the black line
- Is made from wood
- Is covered with wax
- Is 75 feet long to the center of the head pin
- Is 41 1/2 inches wide
- The gutter is 9 5/16 inches wide


The Bowling Pin



- Ten bowling pins per lane
- Made from wood and covered in plastic
- Plastic coating is 35/1000 of an inch
- Weighs between 3 pounds 6 ounces and 3 pounds 10 ounces

The Bowling Ball

- A round sphere, 27 inches in diameter, weighing between 6 and 16 pounds.
- Has three holes:
 - two finger holdes for ring finger and middle finger
 - one thumb hole



Some Bowling Terms



- Strike Knock down all 10 pins on first roll
- Spare Knock down all 10 pins on second roll
- Gutter Ball When the ball rolls into the "gutter".

 There is a gutter on each side of the lane
