Spine / Neck Injuries

Symptoms

- Head held in unusual position
- Numbness or tingling down an arm or leg
- Weakness
- Difficult walking
- Paralysis of arms or legs
- No bladder or bowel control
- Unconscious
- Stiff neck, headache or neck pain
