 - -3-17 covers what CACC "qualification" training is (how to qualify as a marksman, expert, sharpshooter, etc)
 - -3-18 covers Marksmanship
 Competitions like Brigade and State
 Rifle Matches

Cadet Corps Regulation 3-17, 3-18, 3-19

- These regulations govern marksmanship
 - -3-19 explains how the CACC selects its State Rifle Teams that compete against other youth shooting programs in the nation
