Map Reading: Orienteering

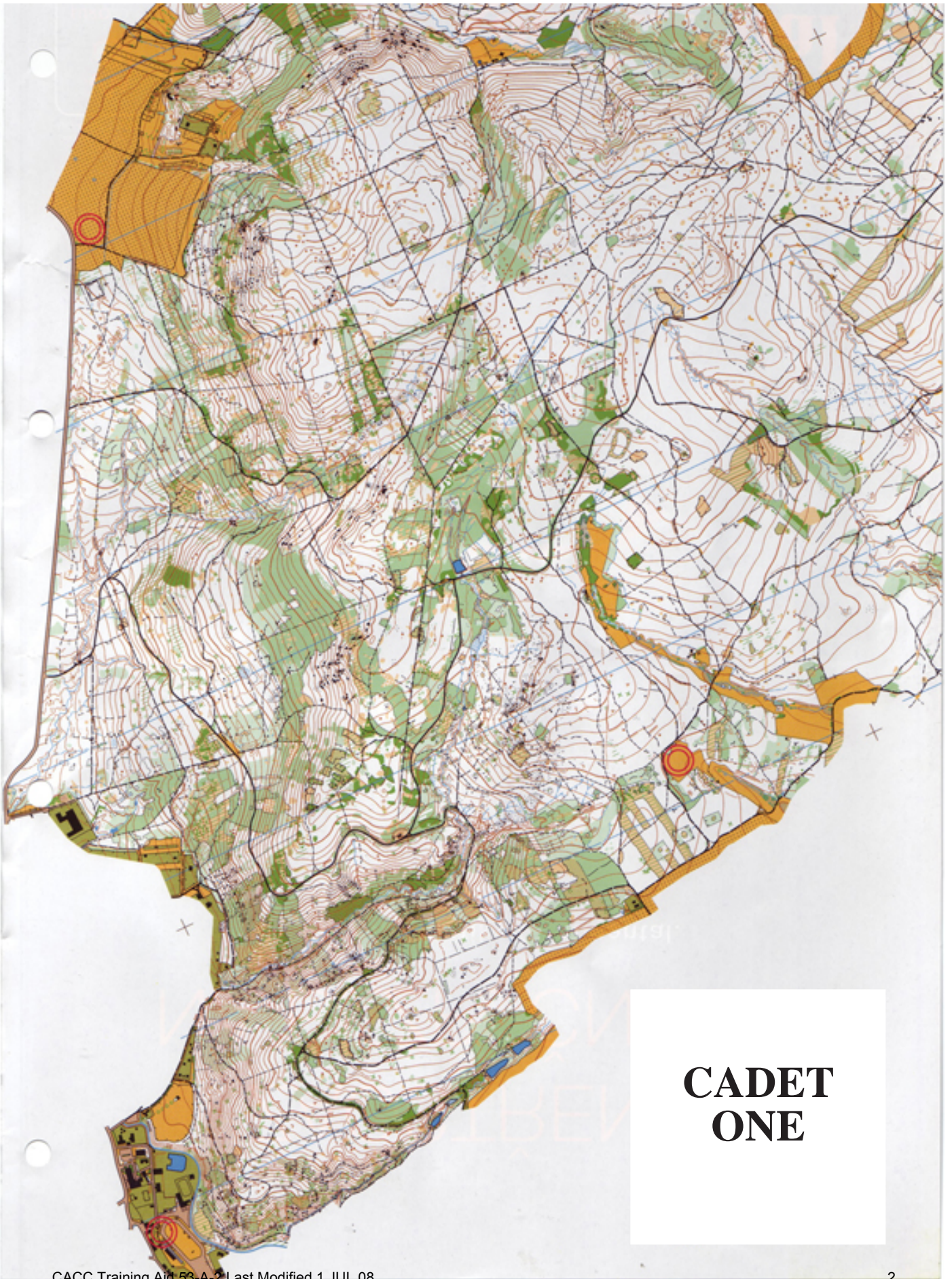
